Sub: Delay in disbursement of salary for April-2020 is creating severe hardship to employees-Reg.

Respected Sir,

We would like to bring to your kind notice that once again the salary has not been paid in time to the employees. It's important to note that starting period of the financial year has additional requirement of fund especially for young employees due to educational fees/books etc in addition to existing loan EMIs, other expenses etc and delay in salary is further aggravating problems. Earlier it was appraised that salary will get regularize after February-2020 as wage bill will reduce drastically on account of VRS by more than 50% of employees. But even after passage of more than three months of VRS, payment of salary on due time has not been achieved while payment of pending medical bills is distant dream.

In present crisis of Covid-19, the employees are putting their life at risk in providing optimum telecom service to customers considering their responsibility as an essential service sector and in return expect some basic support of the organization. Timely payment of salary, clearance of medical bills, provision of insurance coverage and compensation to the dependant of deceased employees are some basic needs of employees. The management should seriously consider settling these needs of employees and if required, matter may be taken up with the administrative ministry to get support for these issues of employees as the government has always shown its concern for the citizens in present crisis.

Therefore, we once again request for immediate disbursement of salary and other due payments to employees. We also request for serious consideration of our appeal to extend insurance coverage and provision of compensation on account of Covid-19 to instill confidence in the employees to work more aggressively towards BSNL.
